COMPLAINT

Summons

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Traffic - DWI - Operate Motor Vehicle Under Influence of Controlled Substance

Minnesota Statute: 169A.20.1(2), with reference to: 169A.25.2

Maximum Sentence: 1 year and/or \$3,000

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 02/20/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16004863

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Jermaine Anthony Taylor, Also Known As Jermaine Taylor And Tyquan Thomas, did drive, operate and have physical control of any motor vehicle when he/she was under the influence of a controlled substance and two or more aggravating factors were present when the violation was committed.

COUNT II

Charge: Traffic - DWI - Operate Motor Vehicle - Alcohol Concentration 0.08 Within 2 Hours

Minnesota Statute: 169A.20.1(5), with reference to: 169A.25.2

Maximum Sentence: 1 year and/or \$3,000

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 02/20/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16004863

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Jermaine Anthony Taylor, Also Known As Jermaine Taylor And Tyquan Thomas, did drive, operate and have physical control of a motor vehicle when his/her alcohol concentration at the time, or as measured within two hours of the time of driving, operating or being in physical control of the motor vehicle was .08 or more, and two or more aggravating factors were present when the violation was committed.

COUNT III

Charge: Traffic Collision - Failure to Notify Owner of Damaged Property

Minnesota Statute: 169.09.5, with reference to: 169.09.14(c)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 02/20/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16004863

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Jermaine Anthony Taylor, Also Known As Jermaine Taylor And Tyquan Thomas, as a driver of a vehicle involved in an accident resulting only in damage to fixtures legally upon or adjacent to a highway, failed to take reasonable steps to locate and notify the owner or person in charge of such property of such fact and of the driver's name and address and of the registration number of the vehicle being driven and shall, upon request and if available, exhibit the driver's or chauffeur's license, and make report of such accident in every case.

COUNT IV

Charge: Traffic-Drivers License-Driving After Revocation

Minnesota Statute: 171.24.2

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 02/20/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16004863

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Jermaine Anthony Taylor, Also Known As Jermaine Taylor And Tyquan Thomas, did after being give notice, or reasonably should have known of the revocation, disobeyed the order by operating in this state any motor vehicle, the operation of which requires a driver's license, while her/his license or privilege was revoked.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant is an Officer with the Mankato Police Department who believes the information set out below is true and accurate based on reports and information submitted to the Officer by Officer Kevin Waterstreet and others identified herein.

On February 20, 2016, at about 8:05 pm, officers were called to the 900 block of Mayvis Blvd. for a report of a collision of a vehicle and a tree. Upon arrival, they observed a red Chevrolet in the yard at that address and that it had collided with a tree in the yard. Officer Knutson ran the registration of the Chevrolet and learned that it belonged to W1, who lived a short distance away. Officer Waterstreet also responded to the incident and was approached on scene by W1, the registered owner. W1 advised the officer that she owned the vehicle and that Jermaine Anthony Taylor, the defendant, had taken the vehicle without her permission, and after crashing it, went to her residence and told her. Officer Waterstreet made contact with Taylor and asked him about the collision. Taylor admitted that he had crashed the Chevrolet and left the scene because he was scared as he had been drinking. He admitted to drinking half a bottle of tequila prior to the collision. While speaking with Taylor, Officer Waterstreet noticed that his eyes were glassy and bloodshot and that his breath smelled strongly of alcohol. The officer requested field sobriety tests and observed six clues of intoxication during the HGN test. During the Walk and Turn test, Taylor failed to touch heel to toe on almost every step and used his arms for balance. He swayed during the One Legged Stand test and used his arms for balance. Finally, the PBT showed Taylor's alcohol concentration to be .21. He was placed under arrest and read the Implied Consent Advisory at 9:09pm. Taylor stated he understood the advisory and did not wish to speak with an attorney. He agreed to take a breath test. Sgt Knutson administered the breath test, which measured Taylor's alcohol concentration at .18 at 9:51 pm. A check of Taylor's driving record showed that his driving privileges were revoked and he had two license revocations from impaired driving incidents on March 28, 2009 and August 29, 2015.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
