COMPLAINT

Warrant

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Drugs - 5th Degree - Possess Schedule 1,2,3,4 - Not Small Amount Marijuana (Gross Misdemeanor)

Minnesota Statute: 152.025.2(1), with reference to: 152.025.4(a)

Maximum Sentence: 1 year and/or \$3,000

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 05/09/2021

Control #(ICR#): 21009949

Charge Description: On or about May 9, 2021, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Jennifer Dorit Weber did unlawfully possess one or more mixtures containing a controlled substance classified in schedule I, II, III, or IV, except heroin or a small amount of marijuana, and the weight of the substance is less than .25 grams or one dosage unit or less and the person has not been previously convicted of a violation of Chapter 152.

COUNT II

Charge: Traffic - DWI - Operate Motor Vehicle Under Influence of Controlled Substance

Minnesota Statute: 169A.20.1(2)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 05/09/2021

Control #(ICR#): 21009949

Charge Description: On or about May 9, 2021, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Jennifer Dorit Weber, did, drive, operate, or was in physical control of any motor vehicle when he/she was under the influence of a controlled substance.

COUNT III

Charge: Indecent Exposure-Public Place Willfully/Lewdly

Minnesota Statute: 617.23.1(1)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 05/09/2021

Control #(ICR#): 21009949

Charge Description: On or about May 9, 2021, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Jennifer Dorit Weber did, in any public place, or in any place where others are present, willfully and lewdly expose the person's body, or the private parts thereof.

COUNT IV

Charge: Tamper With Motor Vehicle/Enter w/o Owner Permission

Minnesota Statute: 609.546(2)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 05/09/2021

Control #(ICR#): 21009949

Charge Description: On or about May 9, 2021, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Jennifer Dorit Weber did intentionally tamper with or enter into or on a motor vehicle without the owner's permission.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On May 9, 2021, at approximately 1:30 p.m., Blue Earth County Dispatch received multiple 911 calls about a naked female walking around and jumping in and out of vehicles at a retail business that sells motor vehicles in Mankato, Minnesota, Blue Earth County. Dispatch received information that the naked woman was in a gold-colored Pontiac SUV and alone in the driver's seat. Dispatch also learned that the woman looked happy and did not appear to be hurt but appeared to possibly be under the influence.

Officers responded to the retail store. Officers observed a gold Pontiac SUV that was running and the driver's side door was open. The car was in neutral. Approximately 15 feet away, officers observed a Chevy Silverado that the rear driver's side door was open. Officers observed feet sticking out of the door. Officer Wood approached the truck and observed a completely naked woman lying across the floor of the second row. The female was lying on her back with her feet in the area digitally penetrating her vagina. The female stated her name was Jennifer Weber from Arlington. Later, identified as Jennifer Dorit Weber. Weber was making nonsensical comments and appeared to be talking to people that were not present. Weber stated she believed she was in a car in St. Petersburg. Officers asked Weber what brought her to the area and she stated to please the boys. Weber continued to masturbate as she spoke with the officers.

Officer Wood attempted to find clothes for Weber in her vehicle. Officer Wood could not find any pants or underwear in her vehicle. Officer Wood observed a mental spoon that appeared to be drug paraphernalia. Officer Wood also observed a crystal substance that later NIC tested positive for methamphetamine.

An ambulance arrived. Officers spoke with Weber for approximately an hour trying to get her out of the vehicle. Throughout this time, Weber was making nonsensical statements and continued to masturbate.

Officers made contact with the owner of the truck. The truck owner stated his vehicle was at the retail store to be fixed on and he did not give Weber permission to enter the vehicle. After prolonged negotiations, Weber eventually got out and was taken to the hospital. After the hospital, Weber was taken to a detoxification facility.

A warrant was obtained for Weber's blood.

A warrant is requested as Weber is in detox.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
