**COMPLAINT**

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Theft-Take/Use/Transfer Movable Prop-No Consent**

Minnesota Statute: 609.52.2(a)(1)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 03/04/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16006211

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Leo Arthur Kump, III, Also Known As Leo Kump Kump, Leo Kump And Leo Arthur Kump, did intentionally and without claim of right, take, use, transfer, conceal or retain possession of the movable property of another without the other's consent and with intent to deprive the owner permanently of possession of the property.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant is an Officer with the Mankato Police Department who believes the information set out below is true and accurate based on reports and information submitted to the Officer by Officer Tiffany Blaschko and others identified herein.

On March 4, 2016, at approximately 11:54 a.m., Officer Blaschko was dispatched to a shoplifting complaint at Wal-Mart, in the City of Mankato, Blue Earth County, Minnesota. The officer was advised by dispatch that a suspect white male with scraggly facial hair, wearing a gray jacket and gray beanie stole a digital watch from Wal-Mart. Dispatch also stated that the suspect was wearing a red backpack. The suspect, later identified as Leo Arthur Kump III, the defendant herein, fled Wal-Mart on a blue Mongoose bike with yellow shocks on the front, after being confronted by Wal-Mart Lost Prevention Agent, W1. Officers searched the area and were unable to locate the Defendant. Wal-Mart Assets Protection Agent, W1, printed a photo of the Defendant via surveillance video, which Officer Blaschko placed in the Mankato Police Department briefing room to identify the Defendant.

On March 4, 2016, Officer McClinton heard, via dispatch, that Officer Blaschko was assigned to a shoplifting call at Wal-Mart. Officer McClinton was shown a picture of the defendant by Officer Blaschko. Officer McClinton recognized the suspect as Leo Arthur Kump III and advised Officer Blaschko of this identification.

Officer McClinton later observed the Defendant riding a Mongoose bike with yellow front shocks and stopped the Defendant in an alley at the 600 block of South Front Street. After having a conversation with the Defendant regarding the stolen property, Officer McClinton physically held up the Defendant's bike to the squad camera so it could be recorded and asked the Defendant various questions regarding the Wal-Mart incident, to which the Defendant denied having being involved. Officer McClinton advised the Defendant that he would be notified as to charges.

Court Administration has advised that the complaint summons mailed to defendant at his last known address has been returned as undeliverable. A warrant is therefore requested.

## SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
