COMPLAINT

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Traffic Collision - Driver Involved Fails to Stop for Collision - Driven or Attended Vehicle

Minnesota Statute: 169.09.2, with reference to: 169.09.14(d)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 05/11/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16013790

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Buay David Duol, did collide with and damage a vehicle which was driven or attended by another person and failed to stop such vehicle and remain at the scene.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant is an Officer with the Mankato Police Department who believes the information set out below is true and accurate based on reports and information submitted to the Officer by Sergeant Ken Baker and others identified herein.

On May 11, 2016, at approximately 2:50 p.m., Sergeant Baker responded to a report of a hit-and-run accident near the intersection of Riverfront Drive and Stoltzman Road in the City of Mankato, Blue Earth County, Minnesota. Sergeant Baker identified one of the drivers involved as Victim 1. Victim 1 indicated that he was driving southbound on Riverfront Drive at the time of the accident. The suspect vehicle was traveling northbound on Riverfront Drive and made a quick left-hand turn in front of Victim 1. A collision occurred. Both Victim 1 and the suspect vehicle drove their vehicles into the parking lot at the Children's Museum. The driver of the hit-and-run vehicle was later identified as Buay David Duol, the Defendant herein. Victim 1 stated that he spoke briefly with the Defendant in the parking lot after the collision. Victim 1 said that he had attempted to obtain insurance from the Defendant. The Defendant expressed concern when about law enforcement being contacted. When Victim 1 indicated he was calling 911, the Defendant said he had a warrant for missing a court date. The Defendant then fled the area on foot, abandoning the vehicle. Victim 1 described the Defendant as having dreadlocks and being a black male wearing a plaid shirt. Sergeant Baker identified a witness as Witness 1. Witness 1 corroborated Victim 1's version of the incident. Sergeant Baker conducted a probable cause search of the unlocked abandoned vehicle. Sergeant Baker located multiple items of paperwork with the Defendant's name on them. Included in the paperwork was a Blue Earth County Summons with the Defendant's name on it. Sergeant Baker obtained a photograph of the Defendant from CIS and showed it to both Victim 1 and Witness 1. Both individuals positively identified the Defendant as the individual involved in the hit-and-run accident. The vehicle was later towed from the scene.

Court Administration has advised that the complaint summons mailed to the defendant at his last known address has been returned by the Post Office as undeliverable. A warrant is therefore requested.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.

Complainant declares under penalty of perjury that everything stated in this document is true and correct. Minn. Stat. § 358.116; Minn. R. Crim. P. 2.01, subds. 1, 2.
