COMPLAINT

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Traffic - DWI - Operate Motor Vehicle Under Influence of Alcohol

Minnesota Statute: 169A.20.1(1), with reference to: 169A.26.2

Maximum Sentence: 1 year and/or \$3,000

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 07/22/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16021725

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Tyler Jacob Reese, did drive or operate and was in physical control of any motor vehicle when he/she was under the influence of alcohol, and one aggravating factor was present when the violation was committed.

COUNT II

Charge: Traffic - DWI - Operate Motor Vehicle - Alcohol Concentration 0.08 Within 2 Hours

Minnesota Statute: 169A.20.1(5), with reference to: 169A.26.2

Maximum Sentence: 1 year and/or \$3,000

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 07/22/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16021725

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Tyler Jacob Reese, did drive, operate or was in physical control of any motor vehicle when his/her alcohol concentration at the time, or as measured within two hours of the time of driving, operating or being in physical control of the motor vehicle was .08 or more, and one aggravating factor was present when the violation was committed.

COUNT III

Charge: Traffic Regulation - Failure to Stop at Stop Signs or Stop Lines at Entrance to Through

Highway

Minnesota Statute: 169.30(b)

Maximum Sentence: \$300

Offense Level: Petty Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 07/22/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16021725

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Tyler Jacob Reese, did as a driver of a vehicle fail to stop at a stop sign or at a clearly marked stop line before entering the intersection, except when directed to proceed by a police officer or traffic-control signal.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant is an Officer with the Mankato Police Department who believes the information set out below is true and accurate based on reports and information submitted to the Officer by Officer William Hullopeter and others identified herein.

On July 22, 2016 at approximately 2:31 AM officers Grassmann and Hullopeter were patrolling northbound on Pole Road in the city of Mankato, Blue Earth County. The officers saw a red Chevrolet pickup westbound on Balcerzak Drive and observed it failed to stop for the stop sign at Pohl Road. The officers pulled in behind the pickup and saw it cross the centerline twice. They also observed the pickup approach Monks Avenue, traveling in the left turn lane however, it continued straight across Monks Avenue rather of turning. The pickup was pulled over and Officer Grassmann approached the driver's window while Officer. Hullopeter approached the passenger side of the vehicle. Officer Grassmann identified the driver by his Illinois DL is Tyler Reese, the defendant. The officer spoke with the defendant regarding the traffic violations and while speaking with him could smell a strong order of alcohol. He also noted that the defendant's face was flushed and that his eyes were bloodshot and watery. The defendant admitted that he had been consuming beer at the Mankato brewery earlier in the evening and had been at other bars as well. Officer Hullopeter requested field sobriety tests from the defendant and during the HGN test observed six clues of intoxication. The defendant also agreed to perform the walk and turn and the one leg stand tests and performed poorly on both of them. He was requested to provide a breath sample for the PBT, however refused. At 2:48 AM officer Hullopeter read the implied consent advisory to the defendant. The defendant stated he understood the advisory did not wish to speak with an attorney and would take a breath test. Officer Grassmann administered the DMT to the defendant which measured the defendant's alcohol concentration at .19 at 3:28 AM.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
