COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Assault-4th Deg-Hospital Emergency Personnel

Minnesota Statute: 609.2231.2(2)

Maximum Sentence: 2 years and/or \$4,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 11/04/2015

On or about November 4, 2015, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Mohamed Hussein Hassan, did, assault and inflict demonstrable bodily harm upon a physician, nurse, or other person providing health care services in a hospital emergency department.

Charge: Assault in the fifth degree; Gross misdemeanor-Within three years of previous conviction.

Maximum Sentence: 1 year and/or \$3,000

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

On or about November 4, 2015, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Mohamed Hussein Hassan,

did intentionally inflict or attempted to inflict bodily harm upon another within three years of a previous qualified domestic violence-related offense conviction or adjudication of delinquency.

COUNT III

Charge: Assault in the fifth degree; Gross misdemeanor-Within three years of previous conviction.

Minnesota Statute: 609.224.2(b)

Maximum Sentence: 1 year and/or \$3,000

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 11/04/2015

Charge Description: Mohamed Hussein Hassan Also Known As Mohamad Hussien Hassan, Mohamed Hassan And Mohamed H Hassan

On or about November 4, 2015, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Mohamed Hussein Hassan did commit an act with intent to cause fear in another of immediate bodily harm or death within three years of a previous qualified domestic violence-related offense conviction or adjudication of delinquency.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On November 4, 2015, at approximately 10:10 p.m., officers with the Mankato Department of Public Safety responded to the Mayo Clinic Health System-Mankato emergency department in the City of Mankato on a report of an assault on a health care worker that had just taken place. Upon arrival, Officer Hoppe observed an injury to V1's face and was advised that the injury was caused by Mohamed Hussein Hassan.

Officers Brett Levin and Steve Hoppe made entry into emergency department room #6 where Hassan was and found him on the bed with blankets pulled over his head. Officer Hoppe pulled the blankets off Hassan and identified himself as a police officer and had Hassan roll on to his stomach so he could be handcuffed. Officer Levin and Officer Hoppe then walked Hassan out to the back side of the ambulance garage where Officer Jacob Price and Officer Mohamed Mohamed were just arriving. Hassan was turned over to Officer Price and Officer Mohamed and transported to the Blue Earth County Jail.

Officer Hoppe then went back into the hospital to speak with V1. V1 advised that she is a social worker and was assisting with the treatment of Hassan. V1 advised that when she entered the room, she was attacked by Hassan who came at her, striking her multiple times with his hands and clawing at her. The injury to V1's left side of her face was red and swelling up while Officer Hoppe was on the scene. V1 advised that the injury was painful to the touch.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
