COMPLAINT

Summons

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Receiving Stolen Property

Minnesota Statute: 609.53.1, with reference to: 609.52.3(5)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 09/10/2015

Control #(ICR#): 15001405

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Adam Robert Raether, Also Known As Adam Robert Raether, did receive, possess, transfer, buy or conceal any stolen property or property obtained by robbery, knowing or having reason to know the property was stolen or obtained by robbery and the value of the property is less than \$1,000.00.

Charge: Pawn Shop Licenses-Prohibited Acts

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Adam Robert Raether, Also Known As Adam Robert Raether, did pawn, pledge, sell, consign, leave, or deposit any article of property not their own; or did pawn, pledge, sell, consign, leave, or deposit the property of another, whether with permission or without; or did pawn, pledge, sell, consign, leave, or deposit any article of property in which another has a security interest; with any license holder.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant is the Chief with the Mapleton Police Department who believes the information set out below is true and accurate based on reports and information submitted to the Chief by Chief Ben Honsey and others identified herein.

In September of 2015, V1 reported that his bicycle had been stolen sometime in August, from his residence in Mapleton, Minnesota. V1 suspected Adam Robert Raither, the defendant, of stealing it. V1 told Chief Honsey that on September 10, 2015, he located the Mongoose Supergoose bike at Pawn America at 1565 Tullamore St. in Mankato, Blue Earth County. Officer Hagen assisted in the investigation and picked the bicycle up from Pawn America. He viewed the surveillance video of the pawn transaction and recognized the person pawning the bicycle as the defendant. Chief Honsey made several attempts to contact the defendant, however, was unsuccessful. The bicycle was valued at less than \$500.00.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
