COMPLAINT

Summons

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Motor Vehicle Registration - Intent to Escape Tax

Minnesota Statute: 168.35

Maximum Sentence: 1 year and/or \$3,000

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 06/29/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16019158

Charge Description: Kunle Olapulumi Showemimo

On or about June 29, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Kunle Olapelumi Showemimo did with intent to escape payment of any tax on a motor vehicle, delayed or neglected to properly list and apply to register the same, or with intent to prevent the payment or collection of the proper tax, fee, or lien thereon, violated or neglected to comply with any of the provisions of MN Statute Section 168.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On June 29, 2016 at about 2:20 p.m., Officer Reinbold was patrolling in the 600 block of East Main Street in Mankato, Blue Earth County. He observed a vehicle parked at that location and noticed that the registration sticker tab on the rear license plate was torn. He ran the license plate and received the information back from Dispatch a few blocks further away. The information indicated that the registration had expired in 2015. As the officer received this information, the vehicle was now being driven and was traveling behind him. He pulled the vehicle over and identified the driver as Kunleolapulumi Showemimo, the defendant. While speaking with the defendant, Officer Reinbold asked him what happened with the registration stickers. The defendant stated that his friend's car was no longer running, so the friend offered to let the defendant use the registration stickers and he did.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
