COMPLAINT

Warrant

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Domestic Assault - By Strangulation

Minnesota Statute: 609.2247.2

Maximum Sentence: 3 years and/or \$5,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 02/09/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16003772

Charge Description: Manachanwa Mark Ogud Also Known As Isaiah Mark Ogud

On or about February 9, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Manachanwa Mark Ogud, did, assault a family or household member by strangulation.

COUNT II

Charge: Domestic Assault-Felony

Minnesota Statute: 609.2242.4

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 02/09/2016

Charge Description: Manachanwa Mark Ogud Also Known As Isaiah Mark Ogud

On or about February 9, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Manachanwa Mark Ogud did, against a family or household member, as defined in M.S.A. 518B.01 Subd. 2, commit an act with intent to cause fear in another of immediate bodily harm or death and has two or more previous qualified domestic violence-related offense convictions or adjudications of delinquency within ten years following discharge

from sentence or disposition for that offense.

COUNT III

Charge: Domestic Assault-Felony

Minnesota Statute: 609.2242.4

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 02/09/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16003772

Charge Description: Manachanwa Mark Ogud Also Known As Isaiah Mark Ogud

On or about February 9, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Manachanwa Mark Ogud, did against a family or household member, as defined in M.S.A. 518B.01, Subd. 2, intentionally inflicted or attempted to inflict bodily harm upon another and has two or more previous qualified domestic violence-related offense convictions or adjudications of delinquency within ten years following discharge from sentence or disposition for that offense.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On February 9, 2016, at approximately 6:51 p.m., Officer Matt Vitale, of the Mankato Department of Public Safety, was dispatched to a residence in Mankato, Blue Earth County, on the report of two cousins fighting. Upon arriving at the scene, officers were not able to find an active disturbance. Officer Vitale was then informed by another officer that Adult1, who was the victim in the incident, was pulling into the parking lot.

Officer Vitale made contact with Adult1 who stated that he lives with his cousin, Manachawa Mark Ogud, date of birth December 15, 1992. Adult1 was able to identify Ogud via a photo. Adult1 stated that Ogud is living with him temporarily while Ogud finds another place.

Adult1 stated he talked to Ogud in the past about Ogud having people over while he was gone. Adult1 stated he did not approve of the people Ogud had been having over and told Ogud this; however, Ogud continued to have people over. Adult1 stated that he again told Ogud tonight that he did not want people over and that if Ogud would not follow his rules, Ogud would have to leave the apartment. Adult1 stated Ogud became angry and assaultive toward him.

Ogud pushed Adult1 onto the couch in their living room. Ogud then pinned Adult1 down on the couch, and Ogud wrapped his hands around Adult1's throat and began strangling him. Adult1 estimated that Ogud strangled him for approximately two minutes. Adult1 stated that he could barely breathe when this was happening and he thought Ogud was going to kill him. Adult1 stated he almost died.

Adult1 was able to get free; at which point, he ran out of the apartment barefoot. Adult1 stated he ran away through the parking lot and around other apartment buildings. Adult1 stated that Ogud pursued him on foot, but did not catch him. Adult1 stated that he believes Ogud is going to kill him.

While speaking to Adult1, Officer Vitale observed scraps on Adult1's left shin and a small round laceration on the right side of Adult1's neck. Officers attempted to make contact with Ogud in the apartment; however, Ogud was not there and his vehicle was not in the parking lot. Officers continued to search for Ogud that evening, but were unable to find him. As Ogud has not returned to his residence and has no other known address, a Warrant is requested.

A record check revealed that Ogud has prior qualified domestic violence-related offense convictions or adjudications of delinquency from November 2009 in court file 07-JV-09-3500 for Third Degree Assault, from August 2010 in court file 07-JV-10-1543 for Domestic Assault, from May 2006 in court file 07-JV-06-400 for Domestic Assault, and from May 2006 in court file 07-JV-06-813 for Domestic Assault.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.

Complainant declares under penalty of perjury that everything stated in this document is true and correct. Minn. Stat. § 358.116; Minn. R. Crim. P. 2.01, subds. 1, 2.
