The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Drugs - 3rd Degree - Poss. Sch 1 or 2 Narcotic, LSD, MDA, or MDMA in School/Park/Public Housing Zone**

Minnesota Statute: 152.023.2(a)(4), with reference to: 152.023.3(a)

Maximum Sentence: 20 years and/or \$250,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 12/26/2015

Control #(ICR#): 15040813

Charge Description: Amanda Lynn Lindblom

On or about December 26, 2015, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Amanda Lynn Lindblom, did on one or more occasions within a 90-day period the person unlawfully possesses any amount of a schedule I or II narcotic drug or five or more dosage units of lysergic acid diethylamide (LSD), 3,4-methylenedioxy amphetamine, or 3,4-methylenedioxymethamphetamine in a school zone, a park zone, a public housing zone, or a drug treatment facility.

**COUNT II**

**Charge: Drugs - 5th Degree - Possess Schedule 1,2,3,4 - Not Small Amount Marijuana**

Minnesota Statute: 152.025.2(a)(1)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 12/26/2015

Control #(ICR#): 15040813

Charge Description: Amanda Lynn Lindblom

On or about December 26, 2015, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Amanda Lynn Lindblom did unlawfully possess one or more mixtures containing a controlled substance classified in schedule I, II, III, or IV, except a small amount of marijuana.

**Charge: Drugs - Possess/Sale Small Amount of Marijuana - No Remuneration**

Maximum Sentence: \$300 fine

On or about December 26, 2015, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Amanda Lynn Lindblom did knowingly or intentionally possess drug paraphernalia; to wit: a smoking device

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On December 26, 2015, at approximately 4:52 p.m., Officer McGinnis of the Mankato Department of Public Safety assisted Officer Hoppe with a traffic stop in the City of Mankato. The driver of the vehicle was D.T., an adult male with suspended driving privileges. The passenger in the vehicle was Amanda Lynn Lindblom, D.O.B. 8-22-1988. Officer McGinnis noted that another officer had taken a burglary report on the previous day in which D.T. was reported as being associated with along with a vehicle that was observed leaving the scene. D.T. told Officer Hoppe that the vehicle associated with the burglary was parked behind a residence near Fifth Avenue in the City of Mankato. Officer McGinnis responded to that area, and Officer Hoppe brought D.T. to the vehicle to speak to officers.

D.T. arrived and was told he was free to go from Officer Hoppe. Officer Fischbach asked D.T. if D.T. would speak to Officer Fischbach. D.T. agreed and told Officer Fischbach that he had been in the area of the burglary in the vehicle. D.T. said that Lindblom had been the one driving. D.T. said that as soon as he saw what was going on, he left the scene. D.T. told Officer Fischbach and officer McGinnis to search the vehicle to verify D.T. did not take anything during the burglary. Officer McGinnis noted that the vehicle is registered to the mother of D.T.'s children, B.L. B.L. is currently in treatment out of state and is Lindblom's sister. Officers learned that Lindblom now possesses and uses the vehicle.

Lindblom arrived on scene moments later and confirmed that she had been in the area of the burglary but also said that they had not taken anything and that they had left after seeing what was happening. Lindblom also gave officers consent to search the vehicle in an effort to clear them as suspects from the burglary. Officer Fischbach and Officer McGinnis began searching the vehicle. Officer McGinnis located a black and green backpack on the front seat. In the backpack, Officer McGinnis located a glass pipe containing a white residue. Another glass pipe containing a white residue and a small amount of marijuana was also located in the center console of the vehicle.

Lindblom said the backpack had some stuff of hers in it but that not all of it belonged to Lindblom. Officers seized the illegal items they had located during the consent search and collected them as evidence. Once back at the Public Safety Center, the backpack was inventoried. The glass pipe that was located in the top pocket of the backpack field tested positive for methamphetamine. The glass pipe located in the center console also field tested positive for methamphetamine. Also in the backpack, the following items were located: a Minnesota driver's license issued to Amanda Lynn Lindblom, mail addressed to Amanda Lynn Lindblom, a checkbook and miscellaneous mail belonging to Amanda Lynn Lindblom, miscellaneous female clothing, a large makeup kit, and other miscellaneous items.

Officers noted that the area in which the vehicle was parked when it was searched is within one city block of public housing in the 1600 block of Fifth Avenue and public housing in the 1700 block of Sixth Avenue.

## SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
