COMPLAINT

Summons

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Liquor-Purchase/Sell/Barter/Furnish/Give to u/21yr

Minnesota Statute: 340A.503.2(1), with reference to: 340A.702(8)

Maximum Sentence: 1 year and/or \$3,000

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 05/16/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16000850

Charge Description: Mathew Dion Saucedo

On or about May 16, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Mathew Dion Saucedo did sell, barter, furnish or give alcoholic beverages to a person under 21 years of age.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On May 6, 2016, Officer Kissling was doing parked patrol on the east side of the City of Madison Lake in Blue Earth County. He clocked a vehicle entering the city at 40 miles per hour in a posted 30-mile-per-hour zone. He stopped the vehicle and identified the driver and front seat passenger as individuals under the age of 21. He also observed containers of alcohol in the vehicle. Officer Kissling spoke with Witness, the front seat passenger; and she admitted that she had consumed alcohol that belonged to the rear seat passenger, Mathew Dion Saucedo, the Defendant. Officer Kissling read the Miranda warning to the Defendant, and he stated that the alcohol was his and that he allowed Witness to drink some, even though he knew she was only 19 years old.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
