COMPLAINT

Summons

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Theft-Take/Use/Transfer Movable Prop-No Consent

Minnesota Statute: 609.52.2(a)(1)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 01/18/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16005202

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Benjamin Joe Revermann, did intentionally and without claim of right, take, use, transfer, conceal or retain possession of the movable property of another without the other's consent and with intent to deprive the owner permanently of possession of the property.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant is an Officer with the Mankato Police Department who believes the information set out below is true and accurate based on reports and information submitted to the Officer by Officer Matthew Vitale and others identified herein.

On February 12, 2016, Officer Vitale spoke with Benjamin Joe Revermann, the Defendant. The Defendant came to the Public Safety Center because he wanted to talk to the officer about another matter regarding V1. During that conversation, the Defendant told the officer that he stole V1's cellphone. He stated that V1 had lost her cellphone somewhere in her house in early January. He was at her residence in Mankato, Blue Earth County, on January 18, 2016, and found her cellphone. The Defendant also stated that he removed the passwords from V1's cellphone and took it with him when he left. His intent was to attempt to find incriminating evidence on the cellphone. During the time he had possession of the cellphone, he extracted the text-message data and printed it. He admitted to the officer that he understood that he stole the cellphone but explained he felt he needed to get this information.

Officer Vitale later spoke with V1 about her cellphone. V1 stated she believed the Defendant stole the cellphone and she was attempting to prove it. The Officer advised her of his conversation with the Defendant and that the officer had taken possession of the cellphone from the Defendant. V1 requested that the Defendant be charged with theft.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
