The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Assault-2nd Degree-Dangerous Weapon**

Minnesota Statute: 609.222.1

Maximum Sentence: 7 years and/or \$14,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 07/01/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16019368

Charge Description: Rachel Marie Davison

On or about July 1, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Rachel Marie Davison did, assault another with a dangerous weapon.

**COUNT II**

**Charge: Stalking - Intent to Injure**

On or about July 1, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Rachel Marie Davison did, against a family or household member, as defined in M.S.A. 518B.01 Subd. 2, commit an act with intent to cause fear in another of immediate bodily harm or death.

### COUNT IV

**Charge: Domestic Assault-Misdemeanor-Intentionally Inflicts/Attempts to Inflict Bodily Harm on Another**

Minnesota Statute: 609.2242.1(2)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 07/01/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16019368

Charge Description: Rachel Marie Davison

On or about July 1, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Rachel Marie Davison did, against a family or household member, as defined in M.S.A. 518B.01 Subd. 2, intentionally inflict or attempt to inflict bodily harm upon another.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Mankato Department of Public Safety Police Officer Jake Green states that on July 1, 2016, at approximately 6:22 p.m., he and Officer Adam Kruger were dispatched to an area in the City of Mankato. The dispatcher provided information that Witness 1 heard screaming coming from a house, and it was going on for about an hour. The officers arrived in the area, and Witness 1 pointed to a residence.

The officers went to the residence and could hear yelling inside and noted that the windows were open. They announced their presence and a female came out the door acting, as Officer Green described, as hysterical. She was subsequently identified as Rachel Marie Davison. A male also came outside and was crying and was identified by the officers as Victim 1.

Officer Kruger spoke with Victim 1, and Officer Green spoke with Davison. She stated that she and Victim 1 had been dating for about four months, and she wanted to break up with him, but he had her tablet. She invited him over to get her tablet back and break up with him. Once she obtained her tablet, she broke up with him and told him to leave, but he refused to do so. They began arguing, and she wanted to leave, but he was restraining her. She eventually ran outside, and he left and drove away. She went back into the house and locked the doors, and he returned. She was unsure how he came inside. They began arguing, and she stated she would call the police, so he took her phone. He told her he was going to call the police if she didn't calm down, and she tried to leave again, but he wouldn't let her. She hit him multiple times to get him off of her.

Officer Kruger noted that Davison did not have any injuries, other than what appeared to be from stepping on glass while she was walking through the house. He had Davison take a seat in the back of the squad car and went to speak with Officer Kruger and Victim 1. He observed that Victim 1 was still crying and had injuries on his face and legs.

Officer Green spoke with Witness 1, who stated that she heard screaming for about an hour. She would hear Davison scream and then hear Victim 1 scream.

Officer Kruger spoke with Victim 1. Victim 1 stated when he arrived, he tried to have a conversation with her, and she blew up at him. She went after him with a pocket knife that he gave her as a gift. He stated that he was yelling at her to leave him alone, and she kept coming up to him and trying to stab him. She cut his leg in a couple of spots with the knife, and the knife should be in the driveway. He also stated that she used her keys. They argued for a while and went inside and continued to argue. She was trying to text people to get drugs, and he took the phone from her and told her to stop it. He advised that he has been trying to keep her off drugs. When he took the phone, they had another big argument. He left the residence and went and knocked on the neighbor's house so he would have a witness of what she was doing. No one answered, so he went down the street.

He went back to the residence, and she had locked the door. He sat outside and asked her to open the door through the window. She was in the residence throwing things around and yelling. She eventually unlocked the door, and he went inside to try to calm her down. While doing so, she was hitting him, scratching him, and throwing things at him.

## SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
