**COMPLAINT**

Order of Detention

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The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Drugs - 3rd Degree - Possess 50 or More Dosages Narcotic Mixture**

Minnesota Statute: 152.023.2(a)(3), with reference to: 152.023.3(a)

Maximum Sentence: 30 years and/or \$250,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 01/21/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16001970

Charge Description: Lyle Robert Haroldson Also Known As Lyle R Haroldson

On or about January 21, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Lyle Robert Haroldson did, on one or more occasions within a 90-day period, unlawfully possesses any amount of a schedule I or II narcotic drug or five or more dosage units of lysergic acid diethylamide (LSD), 3,4-methylenedioxy amphetamine, or 3,4-methylenedioxymethamphetamine in a school zone, a park zone, a public housing zone, or a drug treatment facility.

**COUNT II**

**Charge: Drugs - 5th Degree - Possess Schedule 1,2,3,4 - Not Small Amount Marijuana**

Minnesota Statute: 152.025.2(a)(1)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 01/21/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16001970

Charge Description: Lyle Robert Haroldson Also Known As Lyle R Haroldson

On or about January 21, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Lyle Robert Haroldson did

unlawfully possess one or more mixtures containing a controlled substance classified in schedule I, II, III, or IV, except a small amount of marijuana.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On January 21, 2016 at approximately 3:34 PM, W1 called law enforcement to report that Lyle Robert Haroldson, whom W1 knew to have a warrant for his arrest, had just left Westside Laundry on Front Street in the City of Mankato. Sergeant Jeff Knutson of the Mankato Department of Public Safety responded to the area and spotted Haroldson walking down the alley between Front and State streets.

Sergeant Knutson approached Haroldson and asked him to stop. Haroldson kept walking and Sergeant Knutson closed the distance and asked him to stop again. This time Haroldson complied. Sergeant Knutson asked Haroldson for his identification and Haroldson responded that he did not have any. Sergeant Knutson asked Haroldson if he was Lyle Robert Haroldson and Haroldson confirmed that he was. Sergeant Knutson then had dispatch confirm that there was an active warrant for Haroldson's arrest. There were two warrants for Haroldson, one from Blue Earth County and one from Faribault County.

Sergeant Knutson had Haroldson remove the small backpack he was wearing and handed it to Officer Sean McClinton who had arrived on the scene. Sergeant Knutson then began to search Haroldson. Sergeant Knutson began removing items from Haroldson's outer coat and left pants pocket. In Haroldson's right front pants pocket Sergeant Knutson located a small glass bottle with a cork stopper. Inside this glass bottle was a small plastic Ziploc baggie that had a white residue. Based on Sergeant Knutson's training and experience he believed the baggie had contained methamphetamine. A later field test of the substance showed that it was positive for the presence of methamphetamine. Methamphetamine is Schedule II controlled substance.

Haroldson was stopped directly across the street from the Lutes Travel Building. The Lutes Travel Building contains Mankato Alcoholics Anonymous which is a drug treatment facility.

## SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
