COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Drugs - 5th Degree - Possess Schedule 1,2,3,4 - Not Small Amount Marijuana

Minnesota Statute: 152.025.2(a)(1)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 04/07/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16010002

Charge Description: Jack Alan Robb

On or about April 7, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Jack Alan Robb did unlawfully possess one or more mixtures containing a controlled substance classified in schedule I, II, III, or IV, except a small amount of marijuana.

Charge: Drugs - 5th Degree - Possess Schedule 1,2,3,4 - Not Small Amount Marijuana

COUNT III

Charge: Traffic - DWI - Operate Motor Vehicle Under Influence of Controlled Substance

Minnesota Statute: 169A.20.1(2), with reference to: 169A.26.2

Maximum Sentence: 1 year and/or \$3,000

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

On or about April 7, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Jack Alan Robb did, drive, operate, or was in physical control of any motor vehicle when he/she was under the influence of a controlled substance, and one aggravating factor was present when the violation was committed.

COUNT IV

Charge: Introduce Contraband-Drug/Liquor into Jail/Lockup/Prison

Minnesota Statute: 641.165.2(a)

Maximum Sentence: 1 year and/or \$3,000

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 04/07/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16010002

Charge Description: Jack Alan Robb

On or about April 7, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Jack Alan Robb did introduce or in any manner caused the introduction of contraband into any jail, lock-up, or correctional facility, without the consent of the person in charge, or is found in possession of contraband while within the facility or upon the grounds thereof.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On April 7, 2016, at approximately 10:44 p.m., Officer Waterstreet of the Mankato Department of Public Safety was dispatched to a suspicious vehicle complaint at the Kohl's parking lot. Dispatch received a complaint that there was a black passenger car in the Kohl's parking lot and that someone in the driver's seat had their head down and appeared to be passed out in the vehicle.

Upon arriving at the scene, Officer Waterstreet observed a black Chevy HHR, license number 868 HPW. The vehicle was occupied by a male, later identified as Jack Alan Robb (D.O.B. 8/15/94). Robb was slumped over in the driver's seat when Officer Waterstreet arrived, and he appeared to be sleeping. Officer Waterstreet made contact with Robb and was immediately able to notice that Robb's speech was slurred and he seemed very lethargic. Robb was almost nonresponsive when Officer Waterstreet first began speaking to him. Officer Waterstreet also observed that Robb's pupils were very dilated.

Officer Waterstreet asked Robb why he was sleeping in his vehicle, and Robb was unable to come up with a coherent or rational response. Officer Waterstreet asked Robb to exit the vehicle. He then performed a pat-search for weapons and discovered a box containing a glass paraphernalia pipe containing a white residue and rubber tubing. The glass pipe later tested positive for the presence of methamphetamine.

Officer Waterstreet had Robb conduct several field-sobriety tests. Officer Waterstreet did not observe any noticeable clues of impairment during the HGN test; however, Robb performed unsatisfactorily on the rest of the field-sobriety tests. Robb was asked to provide a preliminary breath sample; however, Robb would put his lips around the straw on the machine but refused to provide a breath sample. Robb was then placed under arrest.

After Robb was arrested, officers conducted a probable cause search incident to arrest of Robb's vehicle. During the search, officers found a cigarette package that contained a small clear plastic baggy which contained a white powder residue and was believed to be possibly pulverized prescription drugs. The officers also found a brown glass bottle containing undetermined white pills/powder that were melted/broken down. These were also believed to possibly be pulverized prescription drugs. Officers then found a rolled-up receipt paper containing two tablets of Alprazolam, a Schedule IV controlled substance.

Officer Waterstreet obtained a search warrant to collect a blood sample from Robb. The search warrant was signed by The Honorable Judge Johnson. He was then transported to MCHS where a blood draw was completed. At this time, the results have not been received from the Minnesota Bureau of Criminal Apprehension.

Robb was transported to the Blue Earth County Jail to be booked in on the charges. Officer Waterstreet was later contacted by the Blue Earth County Jail intake staff who informed him that they had found a small clear baggy containing a white crystallized substance, believed to be methamphetamine. The substance later field-tested positive for the presence of methamphetamine.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
