COMPLAINT

Summons

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Issue Dishonored Check-Value More Than \$250-\$500

Minnesota Statute: 609.535.2a(a)(2), with reference to: 609.535.2a(a)(2)

Maximum Sentence: One year and/or \$3,000

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 08/28/2015

Control #(ICR#): 15033233

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Wilton Allen Landondid issue a check which, at the time of issuance the issuer intended would not be paid, as at the time of issuance the issuer did not have sufficient funds or credit with the drawee and failed to pay the check within five business days of mailing of notice of demand and dishonor, to-wit: the value of the dishonored check, or checks aggregated under paragraph (b), is more than \$250 but not more than \$500

COUNT II

Charge: Theft-Take/Use/Transfer Movable Prop-No Consent

Minnesota Statute: 609.52.2(a)(1), with reference to: 609.52.3(5)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 08/28/2015

Control #(ICR#): 15033233

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Wilton Allen Landon, did unlawfully and without claim of right, take, use, transfer, conceal, or retain possession of the movable property of another without the other's consent and with intent to deprive the owner permanently of possession of the property, to-wit: the value of the property or services is less than \$500.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant is an Officer with the Mankato Police Department who believes the information set out below is true and accurate based on reports and information submitted to the Officer by Community Service Officer Lisa Boehlke and others identified herein.

In October 2015, Mills Fleet Farm reported that the business had sold a shotgun and shotgun shells to Wilton Allen Landon, the defendant, who paid for the item with a personal check in the amount of \$375.25. Mills Fleet Farm employee ALR, reported that he observed Landon present the check for payment of the shotgun and shells to Mills Fleet Farm employee SDGR. Landon's Minnesota ID card was used to identify him. The check was returned to Mills Fleet Farm as insufficient funds and a notice and demand letter was sent by certified mail to Landon. The letter was also returned to Mills Fleet Farm. The telephone number provided by Landon on the check was disconnected.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
