COMPLAINT

Summons

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Disorderly Conduct-Brawling or Fighting

Minnesota Statute: 609.72.1(1)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 03/21/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16008153

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Nina Rose Martinson, did in a public or private place, knowing, or having reasonable grounds to know that it will, or will tend to, alarm, anger or disturb others or provoke an assault or breach of the peace, engaged in brawling or fighting.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant is an Officer with the Mankato Police Department who believes the information set out below is true and accurate based on reports and information submitted to the Officer by Officer Jacob Price and others identified herein.

On March 21, 2016, at approximately 11:18 p.m., officers were dispatched to 529 North 2nd Street for a domestic disturbance in the City of Mankato, County of Blue Earth, State of Minnesota. The caller reported they could hear people screaming inside the residence, and it sounded as if someone was hitting the wall.

Upon arrival by Officer Price and Officer Gilbertson, officers could hear yelling and screaming inside of the residence. Before being able to knock on the residence door, Officer Gilbertson noticed a male exiting the residence, later identified as Victim 1. Victim 1 stated that his sibling was acting crazy and hit Victim 1 on the arm with a wire. Victim 1's sibling was identified as Nina Rose Martinson, the Defendant herein. Officers determined that both Victim 1 and the Defendant, by their own admission, were involved in a verbal altercation that turned physical. Both Victim 1 and Defendant have conflicting stories as to who initiated physical altercation, but both acknowledged they had struck one another.

Defendant and Victim 1 had visible marks on their persons from the physical altercation. Neither the Defendant nor Victim 1 requested medical attention. Victim 1 and Defendant's mother, Witness 1, stated that Victim 1 and Defendant are always fighting and that it is a mutual fight when fighting does occur. Witness 1 also stated to the officers that this was something brothers and sisters do and that Defendant and Victim 1 had been fighting since Defendant moved back home.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
