**COMPLAINT**

Summons

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The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Disorderly Conduct-Brawling or Fighting**

Minnesota Statute: 609.72.1(1)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days and/or \$1,000

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 06/27/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16018976

Charge Description: Jacob Timothy Skinaway

On or about June 27, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Jacob Timothy Skinaway did, in a public or private place, knowingly, or having reasonable grounds to know it will, or will tend to, alarm, anger or disturb others or provoke an assault or breach of the peace, engaged in brawling or fighting.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On June 27, 2016 at about 9:17 p.m., officers were called to the 200 block of Willard Street in Mankato, Blue Earth County, for a disturbance report. The report indicated that eight people were in the street fighting. Officers arrived and spoke with many of the parties involved. Officer Walker spoke with Witness 1, who stated he had just returned home with friends and saw several people at the residence across the street. Witness 1 stated that for no reason, he decided to start recording the group across the street. He stood on the sidewalk in front of his house and recorded the group with his cell phone. Jacob Timothy Skinaway, the defendant, who lives across the street, came to the sidewalk and started recording Witness 1 with his cell phone. Witness 1 then knocked the defendant's cell phone out of the defendant's hand, causing the screen to crack. Witness 1 said the defendant shoved him so he punched the defendant several times. Sergeant Neuman spoke with the defendant who stated that he was in the house when his wife came in and said the people across the street were filming the group on the defendant's front porch. The defendant went out and started taking pictures of Witness 1 until Witness 1 hit the cell phone out of his hand. The defendant stated he told Witness 1 to leave and Witness 1 punched him in the face.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
