COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Drugs - 3rd Degree - Poss. Sch 1 or 2 Narcotic, LSD, MDA, or MDMA in School/Park/Public Housing Zone

Minnesota Statute: 152.023.2(a)(4), with reference to: 152.023.3(b)

Maximum Sentence: Not less than 2 years nor more than 30 years and/or \$250,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 11/15/2015

Control #(ICR#): 15036158

Charge Description: Anthony John Kenning

On or about November 15, 2015, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Anthony John Kenning, did on one or more occasions within a 90-day period the person unlawfully possesses any amount of a schedule I or II narcotic drug or five or more dosage units of lysergic acid diethylamide (LSD), 3,4-methylenedioxy amphetamine, or 3,4-methylenedioxymethamphetamine in a school zone, a park zone, a public housing zone, or a drug treatment facility; and defendant was previously convicted of a controlled substance crime.

COUNT II

Charge: Drugs - 5th Degree - Possess Schedule 1,2,3,4 - Not Small Amount Marijuana - Subsequent Conviction

Minnesota Statute: 152.025.2(b)(1)

Maximum Sentence: Not less than 6 months nor more than 10 years and/or \$20,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 11/15/2015

Control #(ICR#): 15036158

Charge Description: Anthony John Kenning

On or about November 15, 2015, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Anthony John Kenning, did unlawfully possess one or more mixtures containing a controlled substance classified in Schedule I, II, III, or IV, except a small amount of marijuana; and said defendant was previously convicted of a controlled substance crime.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On November 15, 2015, at approximately 10:35 p.m., Officer McGinnis, of the Mankato Department of Public Safety, received a call concerning the whereabouts of Anthony John Kenning, date of birth March 13, 1984, who had a warrant out for his arrest.

Officer McGinnis learned that Kenning was currently at a residence located on Lime Valley Road, in the City of Mankato. The tenant of the residence indicated that law enforcement could come in by the resident's backdoor to look for Kenning. Several officers arrived at the residence and met with the tenant by the backdoor. The tenant said Kenning was asleep on the couch near the front of the residence. The tenant then walked officers inside. Inside Officer McGinnis observed Kenning sleeping in the living room. Officers arrested and handcuffed Kenning without incident. Officers asked the tenant what property belonged to Kenning, and the tenant said the tan winter Columbia jacket next to Kenning and a few other miscellaneous items. Kenning told the tenant to give the jacket to Kenning's mother. The tenant handed Officer McGinnis the jacket instead to take with Kenning and to take out of her residence. The tenant did not want any of Kenning's belongings in her residence. Prior to putting the jacket into Officer McGinnis's squad car and bringing it into the jail it was searched for contraband and weapons. A glass pipe with a white residue was located inside the chest pocket of the jacket. The substance field-tested positive for methamphetamine.

Kenning was transported to the Blue Earth County Jail and held on his active warrant as well as the drug charges. Officer McGinnis noted that Kenning was located in close proximity of the Sakatah Trail, within a park zone, which enhances the current drug charges. A review of Kenning's criminal history reveals a July 30, 2015, conviction for Controlled Substance Crime in the Fifth Degree from Blue Earth County in Court File No. 07-CR-15-1945.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
