COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Assault-3rd Degree-Substantial Bodily Harm

Minnesota Statute: 609.223.1

Maximum Sentence: 5 years and/or \$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 10/08/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16030460

Charge Description: Blake Robert Ammann

On or about October 8, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Blake Robert Ammann did, assault another and inflict substantial bodily harm.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On October 8, 2016 at approximately 1:45 AM Officer Mohamed Mohamed of the Mankato Department of Public Safety responded to an assault call that occurred at Cottage Path near the Timberwolf gate. Upon arriving at the scene Officer Mohammed made contact with Victim 1. Victim 1 stated that the suspect was an individual named Blake Robert Ammann. While speaking with Victim 1 Officer Mohammed noted a large laceration on his forehead that was bleeding heavily. It would later be learned that the laceration is 2 inches in length and would require several sutures to close.

Officer Mohamed then spotted W1 who was standing by Victim 1. W1 provided Officer Mohammed with a description of what had happened. W1 stated that Victim 1 and Ammann were arguing when Ammann grabbed Victim 1 with two hands and pushed him down the steps causing Victim 1's injuries. W1 stated that Ammann then took off his T-shirt and asked if he wanted to fight as well. W1 stated that security then arrived on the scene and Ammann continued to push people and Ammann wanted to pick fights with everyone.

Officer Mohamed then spoke with premier security officer W2. W2 stated that Ammann was the aggressor and that they have dealt with him for some time. W2 stated that they saw the assault occur.

Officer Jesse Gilbertson arrived at the scene to assist. Officer Gilbertson spoke with Victim 1. Victim 1 stated that he was getting off the bus and walking into the apartments when Ammann looked at him and asked 'what the fuck are you doing?' Ammann then shoved Victim 1 and stated that he works there as security (Ammann does not work at College Town as security). Ammann then shoved Victim 1 with two hands and Victim 1 fell to the ground and hit his head on a concrete step.

Officer Gilbertson then located Ammann. Ammann smelled of a heavy odor of alcoholic beverage. Officer Gilbertson took Ammann's T-shirt as evidence as it was covered with blood spatter. Ammann denied striking Victim 1.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
