COMPLAINT

Summons

Tab Charge/Citation Previously Filed

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Traffic-DL-Driving after cancellation-inimical to public safety

Minnesota Statute: 171.24.5

Maximum Sentence: 1 year and/or \$3,000

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 05/08/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16013497

Charge Description: Said Defendant, Anthony Lee Flynn, Also Known As Anthony Flynn, did after being given notice, or reasonably should have known of the cancellation, disobeyed the order by operating in this state any motor vehicle, the operation of which requires a valid driver's license, while her/his license or privilege was canceled; and the Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety has determined that the operation of a motor vehicle on the highways by the person would be inimical to the public safety or welfare.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant is an Officer with the Mankato Police Department who believes the information set out below is true and accurate based on reports and information submitted to the Officer by Officer Adam Kruger and others identified herein.

On May 8, 2016 at approximately 4:40 a.m., Officer Kruger responded to a report of an accident near the intersection of Fourth and Washington Streets in the City of Mankato, Blue Earth County, Minnesota. Officer Kruger reported to that location and determined that a PT Cruiser had struck a parked vehicle. Officer Kruger identified the driver of the vehicle that was involved as Anthony Lee Flynn, the defendant herein. The defendant was not present when Officer Kruger first arrived on the scene. Officer Kruger located the defendant's wallet on the front passenger seat. The defendant later appeared on the scene and ultimately admitted that he had been the driver. At first, the defendant claimed that someone else had been the driver. Later, the defendant claimed that he was avoiding a raccoon that was in the road. The defendant provided a variation of that story by claiming that he was trying to avoid a vehicle that was pulling away from the curb. The defendant eventually admitted that he was driving a friend's vehicle. Officer Kruger identified the friend as Witness 1.

Officer Dale Stoltman assisted in the investigation of the incident. Officer Stoltman identified the owner of the vehicle that was struck by the defendant. That person was identified as Victim 1.

A computer check of the defendant's driver's license record indicates it was cancelled as inimical to public safety at the time of the incident.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
