The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Burglary-1st Deg-Poss Dangerous Weapon/Explosive

Minnesota Statute: 609.582.1(b)

Maximum Sentence: 20 years and/or \$35,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 07/28/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16022419

Charge Description: Shawntay Kiarra Allen Also Known As Shante Kiarra Allen

On or about July 28, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Shawntay Kiarra Allen did enter a building without consent and with intent to commit a crime, or entered a building without consent and committed a crime while in the building, either directly or as an accomplice and the burglar possessed, when entering or at any time while in the building, any of the following: a dangerous weapon, any article used or fashioned in a manner to lead the victim to reasonably believe it to be a dangerous weapon, or an explosive.

Charge: Burglary-1st Deg-Assault Person In Build/On Property

Charge: Threats of Violence-Reckless Disregard Risk

On or about July 28, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Shawntay Kiarra Allen, did threaten, directly or indirectly, to commit any crime of violence with purpose to terrorize another or to cause evacuation of a building, place of assembly, vehicle or facility of public transportation or otherwise to cause serious public inconvenience, or in a reckless disregard of the risk of causing such terror or inconvenience.

COUNT VIII

Charge: Domestic Assault - By Strangulation

Maximum Sentence: 3 years and/or \$5,000

On or about July 28, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Shawntay Kiarra Allen, did, assault a family or household member by strangulation.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On July 28, 2016, at approximately 11:46 p.m., officers with the Mankato Department of Public Safety were dispatched to the Woodside Apartments, in the City of Mankato, in regards to a 911 hang-up call. Dispatch had been notified of the hang-up call in which someone yelling could be heard in the background and a mention about a stalker in the house.

Officers responded to the Woodside Apartments and made contact with a female party that was laying on the first floor at the bottom of the stairways in the main entrance area. The female, Victim, was laying on her side and asking for an ambulance. Officer Grassmann briefly heard the Victim had been choked, was having difficulty breathing, and that Shawntay Kiarra Allen, date of birth September 5, 1993, was the suspect. Officer Grassmann learned that Allen had left the area in a motor vehicle just prior to officers arriving.

Additional officers started looking in the area for the vehicle in an attempt to speak with Allen about the incident. Dispatch then received a 911 call from Allen stating that Allen was going to the hospital and that Allen had been assaulted by Victim.

Officer Grassmann made contact with an adult female witness who lives in an apartment with the Victim. Witness advised that Witness was present when the assault occurred. Witness indicated that she was in a romantic relationship with Victim and that it was suspected that Victim was cheating on Witness with Allen. Witness said that Witness was in her room getting ready for bed when Victim came to the apartment with Allen. Witness mentioned that Witness got into a conversation with Allen about the alleged affair, and that Witness decided to end the relationship with Victim. Witness indicated that Victim and Allen then started physically fighting. Officer Grassmann noted it was mentioned that Allen took the first swing at Victim, and that Victim then swung back at Allen. Officer Grassmann learned the physical fight was to the point of punches being thrown, hair being pulled, and grabbing and tugging on each other. Witness said that Witness was trying to break up the fight and called 911 at the same time. Witness said the physical altercation eventually went out into the hallway and down into the main entrance area where Victim was located when officers arrived. Witness said that Witness did not see the physical altercation in the hallway or the front entrance because Witness was trying to call 911.

Within the apartment Officer Grassmann noticed that a standup mirror was broken, several pieces of hair were in several areas about the living room, and that the area appeared in somewhat disarray. Officer Grassmann also noted a small section of hair in the hallway of the second floor near the stairwell.

Officer Reinbold responded to the incident location with Officer Grassmann. Officer Reinbold spoke to Victim and asked Victim what had happened. Victim said that Allen had come to the building and attacked Victim, pulling Victim down the stairs by Victim's hair. Victim said that Allen has been stalking Victim; and when Victim got to the building that evening, Allen was already there and let Victim in. Medical personnel later arrived and Victim was transported to the emergency room.

Officer Reinbold went to the emergency room and took a formal statement from Victim. Victim provided the following information to Officer Reinbold. Allen had been stalking Victim since Victim moved back to Mankato in March. The stalking was due to a broken off affair Victim had with Allen. On this evening, Victim returned to the apartment building as Victim knew Allen was at the building pushing the doorbell to get in. Upon arriving to the building, Victim was let inside by Allen. Allen then slapped Victim across the face and put her fists up to fight. Victim then put her fists up and ducked a couple of punches from Allen. Victim then grabbed Victim's phone and keys and ran up to Victim's apartment. When Victim got there, Victim ran in and Allen pushed her way into the door past Victim without invitation. Allen then started tell Witness that

Allen and Victim had been involved for some time, and Witness began asking Victim if it was true. Victim denied the allegations, and Allen then grabbed Victim by Victim's hair. The two fought to the ground and Victim said that during the entire fight Allen was pinning Victim's neck to the ground and causing Victim to have trouble breathing. Victim said at one point, Allen was kneeling on Victim's neck and took a scissors and made a stabbing motion toward Victim's face threatening to kill Victim. Allen pulled out Victim's hair and cut some of her hair off. As the fight continued, Allen pulled Victim out of the apartment by Victim's hair and dragged Victim down the stairs of the building and to the front door. Allen then dropped Victim and ran out of the building. Victim said she was scared for her safety and wanted an Order for Protection.

Sergeant Baukol responded to an address on Hilltop Lane in an attempt to make contact with Allen. Officer Mohamed and Sergeant Baukol were walking to the entrance of the apartment when Allen exited the building to speak with officers. Allen indicated she had been in a relationship with Victim for a while and that Victim was upset tonight because Victim got caught cheating. Allen told officers that Victim grabbed a scissors and came at Allen; however, Allen knew Victim would not stab Allen, so Allen told her to put the scissors down and Victim did. Allen stated Victim sat down for a moment but then became upset again and they began physically fighting. Allen did admit to pulling Victim's hair out, hitting Victim, and admitted to getting the upper hand in the fight. Sergeant Baukol was informed that there was probable cause to arrest Allen for domestic assault. Sergeant Baukol informed Allen that because of her relationship with Victim she would be placed under arrest for domestic assault. Allen was transported to the Blue Earth County Jail.

A review of Allen's criminal history reveals a January 3, 2007, adjudication of delinquency for Assault in the Fifth Degree as set forth in Court File #07-JV-06-3767; a July 27, 2011, adjudication of delinquency for Assault in the Fifth Degree as set forth in Court File #07-JV-11-2096; and a July 27, 2011, adjudication of delinquency for Assault in the Fifth Degree as set forth in Court File #07-JV-11-2306.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
